

SECTION 5: CANDIDATE STATEMENT – CAREER-TRACK

Candidate Statement of Accomplishments and Objectives *Statement is 3-5 pages. Attestation may be on the next page if needed, minimum 11-point font.*

Candidates should describe evidence of their achievements in all areas of workload during their period in rank. This narrative can include a statement of teaching philosophy, which may include reflection on teaching goals and pedagogical approach.
