### SECTION 6: TEACHING PORTFOLIO AND RESOURCES – TENURE TRACK AND CONTINUING TRACK

Candidates have the opportunity in the teaching portfolio to represent their teaching through a wide range of information and supporting documentation that demonstrates their teaching quality, outcomes assessment, scholarship in teaching, and innovations in course design.

If a candidate's workload does not include teaching, they do not need to complete this section.

**Do not** include links to drives or folders that permit the owner to track viewership activity (e.g., Dropbox, Google Drive, SharePoint, etc.)

**There are two parts to the Teaching Portfolio.** Each subsection is submitted separately.

- **Section 6A - Information on Teaching and Advising** *will be forwarded to college/university committees.*
  
- **Section 6B - Supporting Documentation (this section is *optional*)** *will NOT be forwarded to college/university committees; this material is summarized in the departmental letters by the department committee and department head.*
  - Section 6B is limited to **no more than 100 pages total.**
